
A BYLAW WITH RESPECT TO LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY IN THE VILLAGE

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARONPORT IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


- 1.No person shall herd cattle at any time within the limits of the Village of Caronport.
- 2.No person shall keep any livestock or poultry at any time within the said Village.
- 3.Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provision of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
