

**BYLAW**  
**Village of Caronport, Province of Saskatchewan**  
**Bylaw #: 2021-08**

**A Bylaw of the Village of Caronport to Appoint a Bylaw Enforcement Officer**


The Council of the Village of Caronport in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw:
  - (a) "Council" means the Council of the Village of Caronport.
  - (b) "Municipality" means the Village of Caronport.
2. Council hereby appoints the Caronport Community Safety Officer as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality.
3. The appointment shall commence September 1, 2021 and shall continue at the pleasure of Council.
4. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving 30 days written notice.
5. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
  - (a) to enforce all municipal bylaws as enacted by Council of the Municipality
  - (b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw; and
  - (c) other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate.
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on September 1, 2021.

**Repeal Bylaw**
