

BYLAW NO. 14/96

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CARONPORT TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 9/89
WHICH IS A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF VEHICLES

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARONPORT IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Bylaw No. 9/89 be amended as follows:

5. PENALTIES be deleted and the following be substituted:

5. PENALTIES

- A). Where any person commits or is alleged to have committed a parking offense under this Bylaw, the following procedures may be followed by the Police or any authorized person:
- (i) A notice in a form to be approved by the Village Council may be given to such a person personally or by mail or by attaching it to the vehicle concerned in such a manner as to be visible to the operator thereof, requiring him/her to appear at the Village Office within seven (7) days from the date of such notice and to pay to the official in charge of the desk thereat, the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) in lawful money of Canada, as a penalty for the infraction described in such notice. Compliance with such notice within the period of the time prescribed therein shall relieve such person from liability to prosecution in respect to such infraction.
 - (ii) Notwithstanding clause (i) of this subsection, where the voluntary penalty is paid within seven (7) days, the voluntary payment shall be reduced to fifteen (\$15.00) dollars.
 - (iii) Non-compliance with any notice described in clause (i) of this subsection shall not in any way affect or prejudice the right of the person named therein to defend any charge which subsequently may be laid against him/her in respect to the infraction described in such notice.

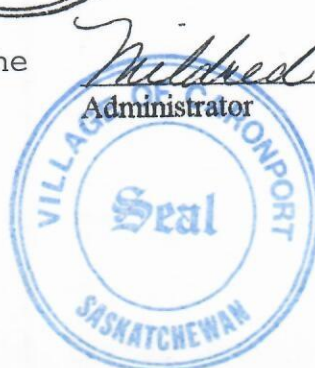
2. This Bylaw shall come into effect upon Third Reading of the same.
